This awe-inspiring geological wonder creates one of the most iconic images of the Caribbean, a tunnel made from angled boulders above shallow, turquoise waters. Snorkeling is available around these beautiful boulders.*

## BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS: Saturday-to-Saturday, Seven Nights



BVI Aggressor's guests embark and disembark from Tortola. Throughout the week, guests may dive several areas of the British Virgin Islands, mainly on the outer islands of Norman, Peter, Salt, Cooper, and Virgin Gorda. The BVI Aggressor has two 25-foot (7.5 meter) Highfield Patrol 760 custom dive tenders each outfitted with tank racks and ladders for easy water exits.

*In October 1867, a hurricane slammed the 310-foot (95-meter) long, iron-hulled RMS Rhone steamship against Black Rock. She broke into two sections. The stern section rests at a depth of 35 feet (10.5 meters) and the bow section lies at 80 feet (24 meters). The Rhone is considered one of the world's greatest wrecks and was even part of the 1977 Hollywood thriller, "The Deep."*



## CAYMAN ISLANDS, BWI: Saturday-to-Saturday, Seven Nights

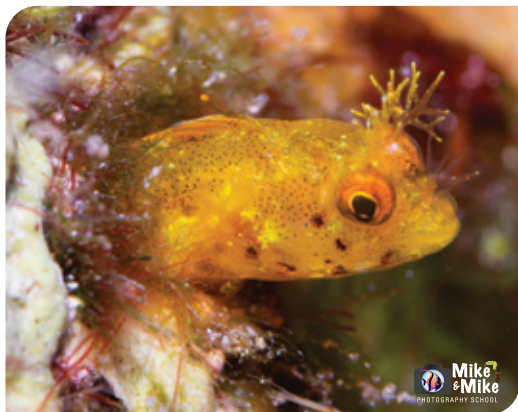

## COCOS ISLAND, COSTA RICA: Ten Nights

The Cocos Island Aggressor® and Okeanos Aggressor II® dock in Puntarenas, Costa Rica with the journey to Cocos Island taking approximately 36 hours. Rocky pinnacles surrounding Cocos are beacons for big animals and big action. Nutrient rich currents attract mantas, tunas, and sharks—silky, whitetip, tiger, whale, and schooling hammerheads. Sea mounts and channels are also home to huge frogfish, eagle rays, and giant marble rays.

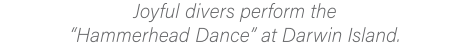
